Azaadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav

On 12th march of 2021, the government of India has kicked off “Azaadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” from Ahmedabad by hailing off '**Dandi March**' from Sabarmati Ashram. March 12 was picked because Mahatma Gandhi began the Dandi Yatra against the English 91 years prior, on March 12, 1930. The Prime Minister also honored the political freethinkers who lost their lives battling for the country's liberty on this occasion. It is a drive of the public authority of India to celebrate and recognize 75 years of autonomy of reformist India and the superb history of its kin, culture, and accomplishments.

The festival begins 75 weeks before the 75th commemoration of Freedom and will end on the fifteenth of August 2023. 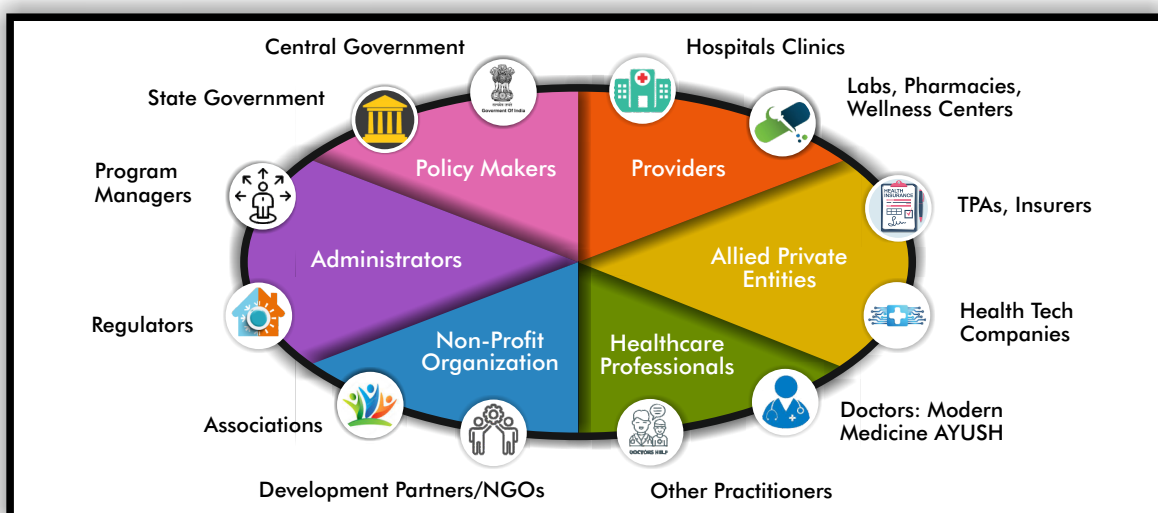
Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission

On 27th September 2021, the Indian government has launched the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) that will connect the digital health solutions of hospitals across the country with the help of a digital health ID card. Every Indian citizen can get this ID card by just registering themselves on the official portal of ABDM which will contain a record of their health status. It will ease the process of a medical consultation with the concerned doctor and can increase the well-being as well.

The Digital system Under Ayushman Bharat mission will alter the present system through which different medical facilities like Digital Consultation, Consent of patients in holding medical practitioners' access to their records, etc. With the implementation of this mission, the government will ensure that recent medical records of citizens cannot wander away as each record will be kept digitally.

The primary goal of ABDM is to ensure that anyone can easily get high-quality medical facilities and health consultations from top practitioners across the country with the help of technology. In a follow-up of the NHP's specific goals for adopting digital technologies, the committee develops an implementation framework for the National Health Stack. This committee created the National Digital Health Blueprint, egg-laying out the building blocks and an action commit to comprehensively and holistically implement digital health. ABDM is the way ahead in this direction.

Objectives of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission

To strengthen the accessibility and equity of health services, together with a time of care because the owner of the data, in a very holistic care program approach investing IT & associated technologies. The ABDM envisages the subsequent specific objectives:

- To establish an improved digital health system and manage the core digital health knowledge, and develop a support infrastructure needed.
- To establish repositories at an optimal level to create a single source of information concerning clinical institutions, care professionals, medical examiners, medication, and pharmacies.
- To establish a system of private health records, supported international standards, which is easily accessible to people and care professionals and services suppliers, supported individual's level of consent.
- To promote the enterprise-class health application systems with a specialization in achieving the property development goals for the same.
- To adopt the principles of cooperative federalism while operating with different stakeholders at the States and Union Territories for the realization of this vision.
- To ensure that the private sector in the medical practitioner and care segment will participate actively with public health authorities within the ABDM objectives through prescription and promotion.
- To ensure the national movability of medical practitioners and services.
- To promote the employment of clinical call support systems by health professionals and practitioners at all levels.
- To promote higher investment in the health sector, health information analytics, and medical research.
- To support effective steps being taken for making the standard of healthcare certain.

The implementation of this scheme is predicted to considerably improve the potency, effectiveness, and transparency of health service delivery in India overall. Patients will be ready to firmly store and access their medical records and share them with health care suppliers to confirm applicable treatment and follow-up. They are going to even have access to additional data on health facilities and medical suppliers. Further, they must be going to have the choice to access health services remotely through teleconsultation and e-pharmacy services. ABDM can empower people and

practitioners with correct and easy access to data to decide and increase the responsibility of health care suppliers in the ecosystem over time.



ABDM can offer options to people to access each public and personal health service, facilitate compliance with ordered down tips and protocols which guarantee transparency in the evaluation of services and responsibility for the health services being rendered. Similarly, health care professionals across disciplines can have higher access to patients' medical records for prescribing additional applicable and effective health interventions. This can enhance the ease of providing services amongst the health care suppliers soon.



Swacch Survekshan 2022

The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs on September 27, has dispatched the Swachh Survekshan 2022. According to the world largest cleanliness survey conducted by Swachh Bharat mission- Urban (SBM-U), it is the **7th successive version** of Swachh Survekshan With '**Individuals First**' as the driving way of thinking, the Swachh Survekshan 2022 was dispatched at New Delhi including drives of urban areas for the general government assistance and prosperity of cutting edge sterilization laborers. With this, MoHUA additionally starts off the extended festivals of 'Azaadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' with the Azaadi@75 spirit.

The goal of the review is to support huge scope of resident investment, guarantee the manageability of drives taken towards trash-free and open defecation-free urban communities. That will give sound results on the ground and would be approved by outsider confirmation, regulate existing frameworks through web-based cycles, and make mindfulness among all areas of society. This will also increase the awareness about the significance of cooperation towards making towns and urban areas more livable and maintainable. Furthermore, the review likewise means to encourage a feeling of solid contest among towns and urban areas to further develop their administration conveyance to residents and move towards making cleaner urban communities.

Since the beginning of SBM in 2014, metropolitan spaces of 23 states/Uts have become open defecation-free, and over 94% of urban areas are now open defecation-free. Almost 63 lakh individual family has toilets (94% advancement), and more than 5 lakh local area/public toilet seats (over 100% advancement) have been built over the time. According to a recent study, Around 42,000 public toilet blocks throughout 1400 urban areas have been planned and noticeable on Google maps, which is a great milestone in urban cleanliness planning. The Google public toilet finder likewise gives a choice to residents to give their criticism after utilizing the toilet. Squander preparing has increased to 52% (contrasted with a simple 18% toward the beginning of the Mission).

Key features of Swachh Survekshan 2022

- This year small cities and towns will also be considered in the survey of cleanliness under the mission. The cities will be broadly divided into two categories based on their population of 15,000 and between 15,000 -25,000 respectively.

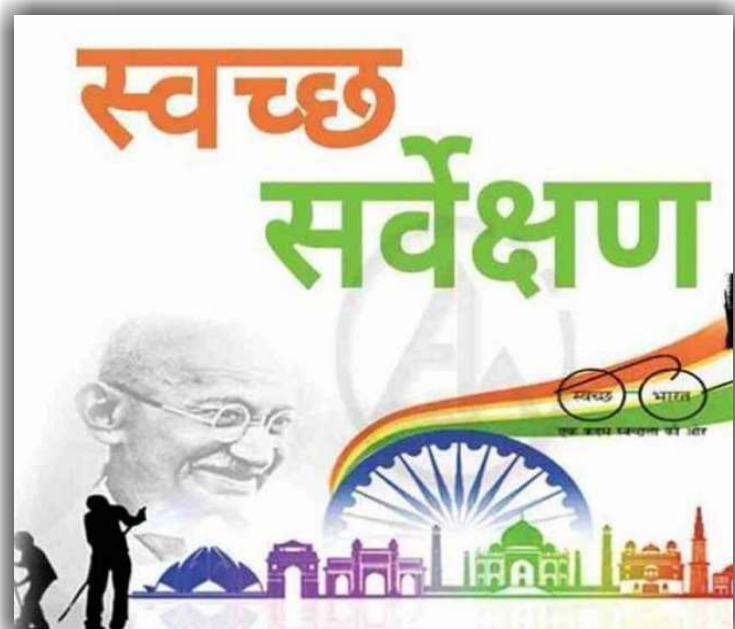
- Under this mission, A coffee table book has been released by MoHUA whose title is ' A change of heart' which is a compilation of stories of individuals and communities to inspire the public at large for urban cleanliness.
- A rightly needful step to provide PPE to sewage and septic tank cleaners has been adopted because they are the ones who put the battle with the cleaning operation and face safety concerns on the front.
- The engagement needs of women, transgenders, and persons with disabilities have been taken on priority.
- The aim of consistently carrying this mission and multi-face projects is set to approach a circular economy through optimum resource recovery.

Interestingly, the Swachh Survekshan 2022 will have the positioning of regions also, which will extend the impression of the neatness overview as a whole. The overview's extension was extended to cover 100% wards for testing when contrasted with 40% in the earlier years which is a welcome step. This year, the neatness overview will have over two times the quantity of assessors sent a year ago. It will present
