Sustainability Perception Index by SIDBI to Promote Sustainability among MSMEs

In today's world sustainability has become a prime business objective globally. In this regard, Indian MSMEs (Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises) are no exception. To label these challenges, SIDBI (Small Industries Development Bank of India) and D&B (Dun and Bradstreet) signed an MoU for launching a quarterly Sustainability Perception Index (SIDBI–D&B SPeX) Survey that was announced last year (October – December 2022). In its latest report, the **SPeX score for April-June 2023 stands at 46 witnessing a decline from 54 in the previous quarter i.e. January-March 2023**.

Objectives of SPeX



The SPex Index differentiates various MSMEs into four categories as per their performance towards achieving ambitious targets through sustainable processes.

It is important to understand the current situation of sustainability perception for MSMEs in India and act on it using SPeX to proactively support the green mission to address environmental issues, minimize the variety of losses, and counter climate change as they might affect business development across sectors.



Major Highlights of Apr-June 2023 SPex Index

8 in 10 MSMEs feel need to improve awareness of sustainability measures, policies, procedures for adoption of sustainable practices. 1 in 10 MSMEs are recycling more than 75% of water consumption. MSMEs face a pressing requirement for technical support and capital to embrace sustainability initiatives and these are among their top three challenges. SPEX category "SPeX Leaders" view sustainability initiatives as a requirement when it comes to collaborating with clients. Whereas for "SPeX Integrators", "SPeX Aspirers", and "SPeX Followers" categories, sustainability measures serve as valuable guidance for responsible governance. Cost reductions via efficiency gains and external factors are major drivers of MSME's sustainability actions. Positive impact on revenue and employee morale are the top expected positive outcomes of their sustainability actions. Environment-related initiatives such as reducing, reusing, and recycling; and employee welfare, training and retention remain in top three sustainability priorities.

The latest report explains that there is a 20% decline in implementation, a 17% decline in willingness, and an 11% decline in awareness scores achieved by MSMEs. SIDBI-D&B SPeX index is mastered to assess the sustainability perception of Indian MSMEs across different industries and locations. The ESG (Environmental Regulations, Social Responsibility, and Governance Practices) framework plays a vital role in maintaining Sustainability Perception to benefit overall growth.

India Launched World's First BS6 (Stage II) Prototype of 'Electrified Flex Fuel Vehicle'

The BS 6 Stage II 'Electrified Flex fuel vehicle' was launched in India on 29 August 2023 by Toyota Kirloskar Motor based on the Innova Hycross technology. It will be the world's first electrified flex fuel vehicle engineered by Toyota to follow India's emission standard norms and revolutionize the domestic as well as global automobile industry.

The acronym 'BS' stands for 'Bharat Stage', the emission norms instituted by the Government of India to regulate air pollution from internal combustion engines. India has advanced its BS6 norms rollout in 2020, which was earlier scheduled in 2022.

The rolling out of BS VI norms along with **advances of targets set for ethanol blending to 2025 from early 2030 target**, has set the right and ambitious path for India's 'Atmnirbharta' in clean energy and reduce air pollution significantly to achieve net zero emission targets with the set timelines.

This vehicle has a dual system of a flex fuel engine and an electric powertrain. Flex fuel is an alternative made by mixing petrol with ethanol (@20%) called E20 fuel and thus the electric power train generates and delivers power to electric vehicles while the engine is off. Resulting in faster decarbonization and fighting against climate change with the ability to run 40-60% on EV mode at engine shut-off conditions and provide 30-50% fuel efficiency.

The ministry view for the upcoming stages of this prototype under careful changes, approval, and certification processes is also promising to make it more reliable as per the Indian emission norms over time.
