




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'Foundational Literacy and Numeracy Assessment Test' was Conducted as Part of ULLAS - Nav Bharat Saaksharta Karyakram

Under the initiative, ULLAS - Nav Bharat Saaksharta Karyakram the Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL) under the aegis of the Ministry of Education successfully conducted the Foundational Literacy and Numeracy Assessment Test (FLNAT) on 17 March 2024. The officials expected around 37 lakh aspirants to appear in this important test which was conducted across 23 states in India.





The test evaluates the outcome of the learning sessions imparted by the teachers and is considered a vital instrument to identify the root cause under the **ULLAS** initiative subsequently introducing needed arbitration to witness substantial growth in literacy rate. Under this volunteer initiative, adults aged 15 or above have been provided knowledge of basic literacy, and numeracy along with critical life skills that will foster their lifelong learning.

It consists of three subjects Numeracy, Reading, and Writing scoring 50 marks each. It is conducted in every district of the participating States/Union Territory, and assisted by the District Institutes of Education and Training (DIETS), a n d Government/aided schools play a vital role as test centers.




The FLNAT syncs with the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 to achieve the goals of Jan Jan Saakshar Bharat and Viksit Bharat. It is conducted in regional languages to foster multilingualism and to promote the use of the native language of the learner as the medium of instruction.

In 2023, two FLNATs were conducted in March and September, the last one held on 24 September witnessed 17,39,097 learners but only 15,58,696 got certified. Since its inception, 36,00,870 learners have been certified who got certificates from the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS). Some UTs like Goa, Chandigarh, Lakshadweep, and Puducherry are planning to achieve 100% literacy via FLNAT.





Registration for APAAR ID is open for all students and it's a voluntary process rather than a mandatory process. After successful registration, a student is assigned a permanent and unique 12digit APAAR ID as part of centralized data for students' academic details accessible at a single point of contact. Towards the vision of achieving the Digital India mission, India has already witnessed around 25 crore APAAR **IDs** and counting many more.



This initiative is acknowledged as a significant tool that plays a vital role at the national level in tracking the academic advancement of around 260 million students. 

The objective of the AISHE is to incorporate all r e q u i r e d information on various parameters including teacher, infrastructural information, student enrolment, etc.






The AISHE survey was started in 2011 since then, it has collected information about Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) in the country that are registered with it.


In comparison to the AISHE 2014-15 survey, the enrolment in higher education has increased in the 2021-22 all-India survey. **The PhD enrolment in this period has seen a significant increase of more than 81% which also included higher female PhD enrolment.**




Gender-wise Enrolment Distribution of Top 10 States

Estimated Enrolment Distribution at various Levels of Higher Education





The survey has also included the availability of additional infrastructure facilities in various universities across the country that enhance the overall environment of outcome-based learning. This time the marginal betterment of female faculty ratio per 100 male faculty has also seen an increase of 77 from earlier 75.
