VIII. **LOOKING AHEAD**

1. **SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE**



An innovative approach to promoting sustainable agriculture practices in the Himalayan Region. Circular value chain and low-emission Agri practices is directly contributing to NDCs and increase incentive opportunities for the farmers.

The concept of circular economy revolves around closing the loop of resource use, minimizing waste, and maximizing the economic value of the product from seed to market. Use of technology for precision and low-emission farming techniques are efficient solutions. AG Horizon team is working on developing a robust business strategy while factoring circular value chain for the agriculture sector. The objective is to empower farmers, entrepreneurs, youth, SHGs and the government by providing technologies, required knowledge, and economic support while maintaining and encouraging climate-efficient agriculture practices.

2. **INCENTIVIZING URBAN GREENS**



Urban green spaces hold the potential to combat climate change's impact on the urban fabric. In addition to this common knowledge, these green covers can also generate revenue for the local government authorities in the form of multiple instruments. AG is exploring such revenue-generation instruments to monetize these green covers.

Avenue Plantations including hedgerows, Shrubs, Trees, etc., Urban forests, parks, gardens, and recreational green and blue areas, etc. holds multiple benefits such as a few mentioned below:

- **Contribute to Emission Reduction**
- **Increase Water Retention Capacity**
- **Reduce Relative Temperature**
- **Improve Air Quality**
- **Enhance Biodiversity, Etc**

These benefits highly advocate for the increase and maintenance of the green cover but at the same time demand for high investment. AG Horizon team is working on conceptualizing plan to address this challenge by providing innovative solutions to incentivize these opportunities through credit mechanisms, Revenue generation through Sponsorship, and attracting impact investment.

3. A COLLABORATIVE APPROACH TO BOOST FOREST ECONOMY



The collaborative model is a dynamic approach to boosting the forest economy while establishing sustainable and equitable management of resources. Forest holds the potential for environment preservation, resource provision as well as incentivization through credit generation. Areas where the ownership of the forest land is fragmented are at higher risk of deforestation but lucrative incentives can play a valuable role in conserving the same.

With the guiding principle of respect for land ownership, skill development shared benefits, and increasing forest cover, AG team is working with the stakeholders to develop a Collaborative Business Model. CBM is targeted to create a collaborative network of diverse stakeholders that would serve as a mechanism to preserve and unlock forest potential. The idea is to formulate a synergy between the government, Private land owners/community & other supporting agencies to preserve forest cover while maximizing profit for stakeholders creating a win-win situation.
